GUIDELINE NUMBER 3 OF THE CHIEF COMMANDER OF THE POLICE of 30 August 2017

on the performance of certain investigative activities by police officers

The guidelines set out the activities and the sequence of pre-trial proceedings which have a particularly significant impact on the correctness of police investigative activities carried out during the conduct of proceedings and activities ordered by a public prosecutor, court or court registrar. They set out, among others, how reports of crime should be received, the rules of conducting investigations

and performing procedural steps to the extent necessary to protect traces and evidence of a crime from loss, distortion or destruction; how the orders to initiate an investigation should be issued; what the evidentiary steps should look like.
