Removing a child

ORDINANCE OF THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS of 31~March~2011 on the procedure of removing a child from a family in the event of imminent danger to the child's life or health due to domestic violence

The ordinance sets out the procedure followed by the police when carrying out the action of taking a child from the family by a social worker and placing the child with another non-cohabiting relative, in a foster family or in a 24-hour care facility, in the event of a direct threat to the child's life or health due to domestic violence and the manner of documenting the action.
