

Removing a child

**ORDINANCE OF THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS of 31 March 2011
on the procedure of removing a child from a family in the event of
imminent danger to the child's life or health due to domestic violence**

The ordinance sets out the procedure followed by the police when carrying out the action of taking a child from the family by a social worker and placing the child with another non-cohabiting relative, in a foster family or in a 24-hour care facility, in the event of a direct threat to the child's life or health due to domestic violence and the manner of documenting the action.
